Area covered
Peshawar, Nowshera,
Charsadda, Mardan, Swat,
Shangla, Lower Dir, Upper Dir,
Malakand, D I Khan and Tank

Criteria Used

- ***Main Criteria:*** Households whose food and daily use assets are washed away
- ***Verifiable Indicators:***
 1. Houses where water still stands (at time of survey)
 2. Houses completely destroyed
 3. Houses severely damaged (non-livable)

Duration and manpower

Duration: 30 July to 7st August 2010

82 teams with 2-3 persons each (221 numbers)

Methodology:

1. Visit the affected villages/area
2. Personal observations
3. Transect walk
4. Short interview with the villagers/
representatives
5. Desk review of existing data/information
